As the deportations and the forced use of the Yellow Star of David started in June 1942 and also no. 40 came to the school only during 1941 and that after 1941 non Jewish teacher were not allowed anymore to teach at the Jewish schools, and Edith Kroch (See under 157) came to the school in September 1941 and is not on this picture

Her sister Edith, 1927, went to school from September 1941 till July 1942. Therefore not on this picture. Her mother Ella was caught at the Dutch border and murdered in Ravensbruck.
